

Vaccine Coverage for Medicaid FAQs

All adults covered by Medicaid have all CDC-recommended vaccines covered **FREE** without any out-of-pocket costs.



Does this include vaccines for pregnant people?

Yes. COVID-19, flu, Tdap, and RSV are all recommended by CDC for pregnant people, including Medicaid recipients. This means there are no out-of-pocket costs with these vaccines for pregnant people.

Does this include vaccines that are recommended by CDC with shared clinical decision making?

Yes, vaccines recommended by CDC with shared clinical decision making are available at zero cost to the patient.

When did this change occur?

This change occurred on October 1, 2023, as a result of a new law.
