Medicare beneficiaries now have all CDC-recommended vaccines covered **FREE** without any out-of-pocket costs, including vaccines covered under Part B and Part D.



Does this include vaccines that are recommended by CDC with shared clinical decision making?

Yes, vaccines recommended by CDC with shared clinical decision making are available at zero cost to the patient.

When did this change occur?

This change occurred on January 1, 2023, as a result of the Inflation Reduction Act.


